If you are over 18 you have the right to make a Will.

A Will lets you say how you want your personal items and assets distributed after you die; you can also say who you would like to care for your children.

What if I die without a Will?

- It can place a burden on your family at a sad and stressful time
- It may take time and money to sort out who gets your personal items
- Your wishes will not be known, so there could be family arguments.



A Will needs changing as your life changes

You may need to update your Will if you:

- move in with your partner
- get married
- have a child or grandchild
- separate from your partner
- get divorced
- have a change to your assets.
